TO THE DEPOSITORS OF THE BIRNIETRUST COMPANY OF TANEYTOWN, MARYLAND.

Due to the present financial crisis and because of the depressed conditions existing today, The Birnie Trust Company along with many other Banks in the country has suffered a severe depreciation in the value of its assets.

After making allowances for certain surplus adjustment a recent appraisal of our assets shows depreciation amounting to \$292,862.29 and because of this depreciation the Bank Commissioner of Maryland has placed our Bank on a restricted withdrawal basis of 5 percent and in order that our Bank may resume business on a 100 percent basis a plan of reorganization is necessary.

The plan of reorganization suggested and which has the approval of the Bank Commissioner will permit the present capital of \$40,000.00 and surplus of \$20,000.00 to remain and to create a Guarantee Fund of \$300,000.00 to be subscribed by the present depositors of the Bank. In order to raise this Guarantee Fund it is necessary that 30 percent of the total deposits be voluntarily assigned to the Guarantee Fund.

THIS GUARANTEE FUND WILL BE REPAID TO THE DEPOSITORS when the earnings of the Bank will, in the judgment of the Directors permit and when authorized and approved by the Bank Commissioner. Until the Guarantee Fund is repaid in full to the Depositors no dividend on the stock can or will be declared.

The Officers and Directors feel that the interests of the Depositors will best be served by resuming normal business at as early a date as possible and the co-operation of our depositors is essential and will greatly assist in completing this plan of readjustment.

It would take considerable time if it becomes necessary to approach each depositor personally because of the large number of accounts and we therefore ask that you co-operate with us by bringing or sending to the Bank the enclosed agreement properly signed and witnessed as promptly as possible.
