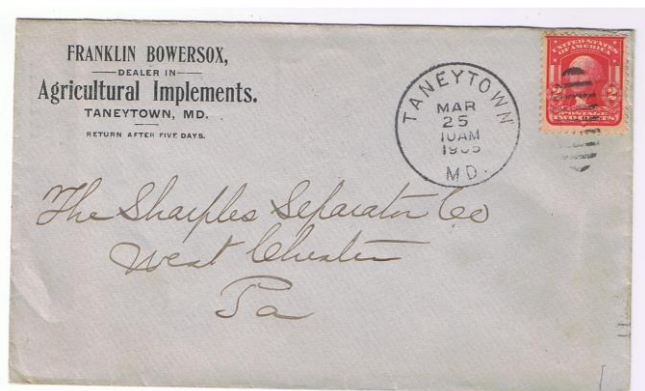

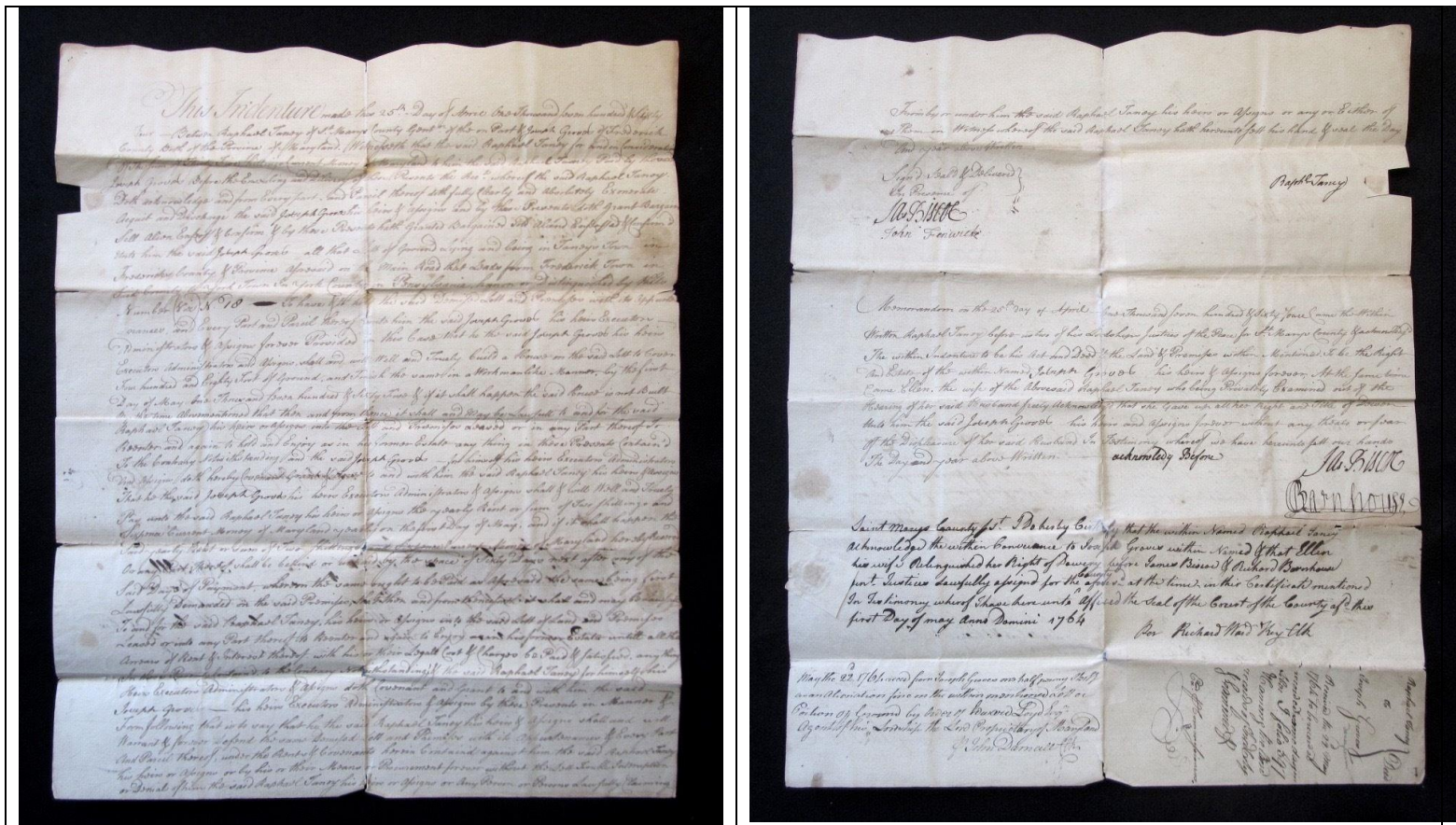
Taneytown, MD – OUAM Ribbon

Early 1900's Junior Order of United American Mechanics original ornate badge and ribbon. It was issued to a member for Council No.99 held at Taneytown, Maryland. Reverse has black ribbon with silver lettering probably as "In Memoriam" salute to members who died. Total length is 8" long.

VERY RARE original 1764 land contract document signed by **RAPHAEL TANEY** (original land grant recipient and founder of Taneytown, MD) as the seller of land parcel, Lot #18 in “Taney’s Town,” this contract being one of the first issued for land in Taneytown, MD! Two pages on one leaf, 15 1/4” X 12 1/2”, signed by Taney on the recto, with scalloped upper edge and four docket holes.

A sample of document reads “This indenture made on the 25th day of April, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Four, between Raphael Taney of St. Mary’s County Gentleman of the one part and Joseph Groves of Frederick County, both of the Province of Maryland. Witnesseth that the said Raphael Taney for and in consideration of the sum of thirty-five shillings current money of Maryland to him the said Raphael Taney paid by the said Joseph Groves before the unsealing and delivery of those presents the received to whereof the said Raphael Taney doth acknowledge and from every part and parcel thereof doth fully clearly and absolutely exonerate acquit and discharge the said Joseph Groves his heirs and assigns and by the presents doth grant bargain sell alien employ and confirm and by the presents hath granted bargain sold alien employ and confirm unto him the said Joseph Groves all lots and ground lying and being in Taney’s Town in Frederick County and Province aforesaid on the Main Road that leads from Frederick Town in said county to York Town in York County in Pennsylvania known or distinguished by lot Number vis No. 18...”.

Taneytown was founded in 1754 when Raphael Taney and Edward Diggs received one of the area’s first land grant known as “Brother’s Agreement”, containing a total of 7,900 acres. Lots were sold off starting in 1762. Taney acquired the land for monetary purposes, residing in St. Mary’s County, MD. He did, however, help in the design of the town’s layout and gave it his name.

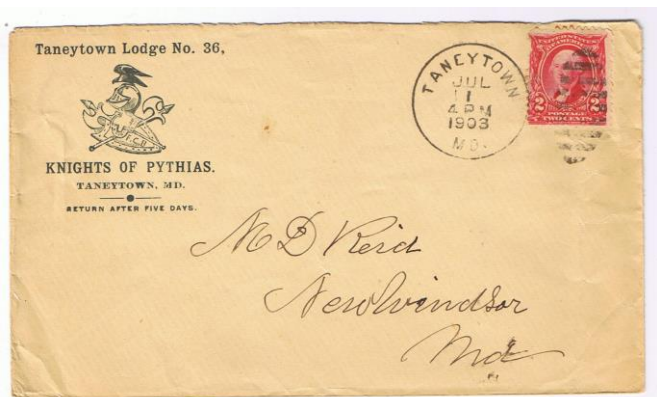

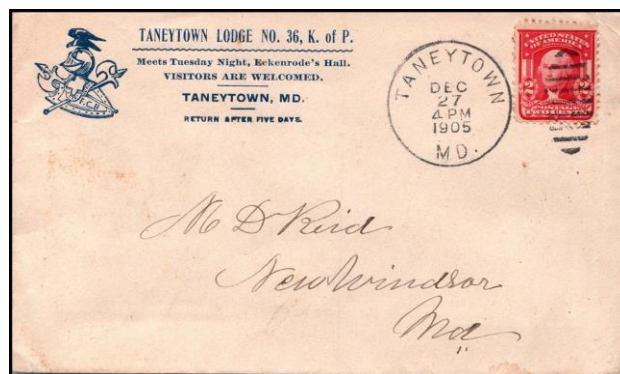
Taneytown, MD - Generic Stock Certificate Book

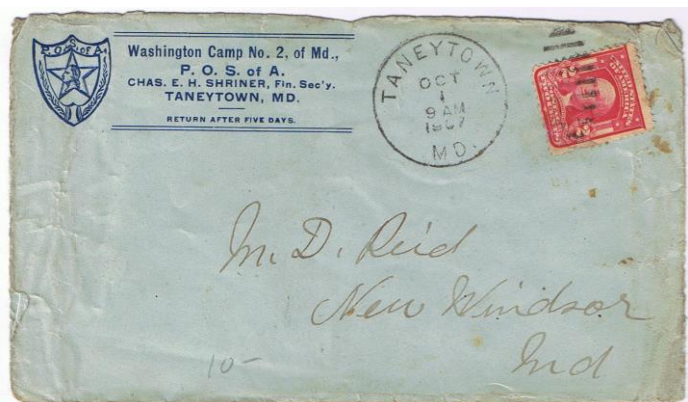

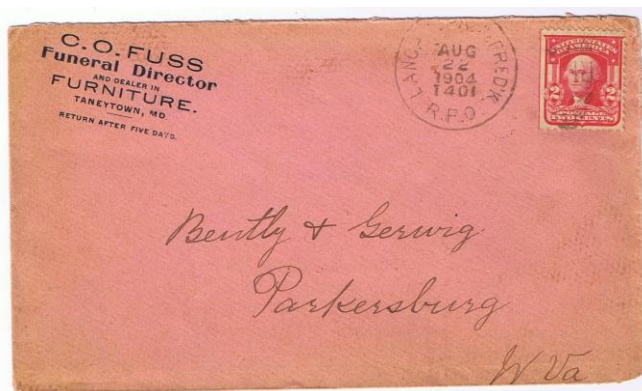
Taneytown, MD - Envelope – July 1, 1903

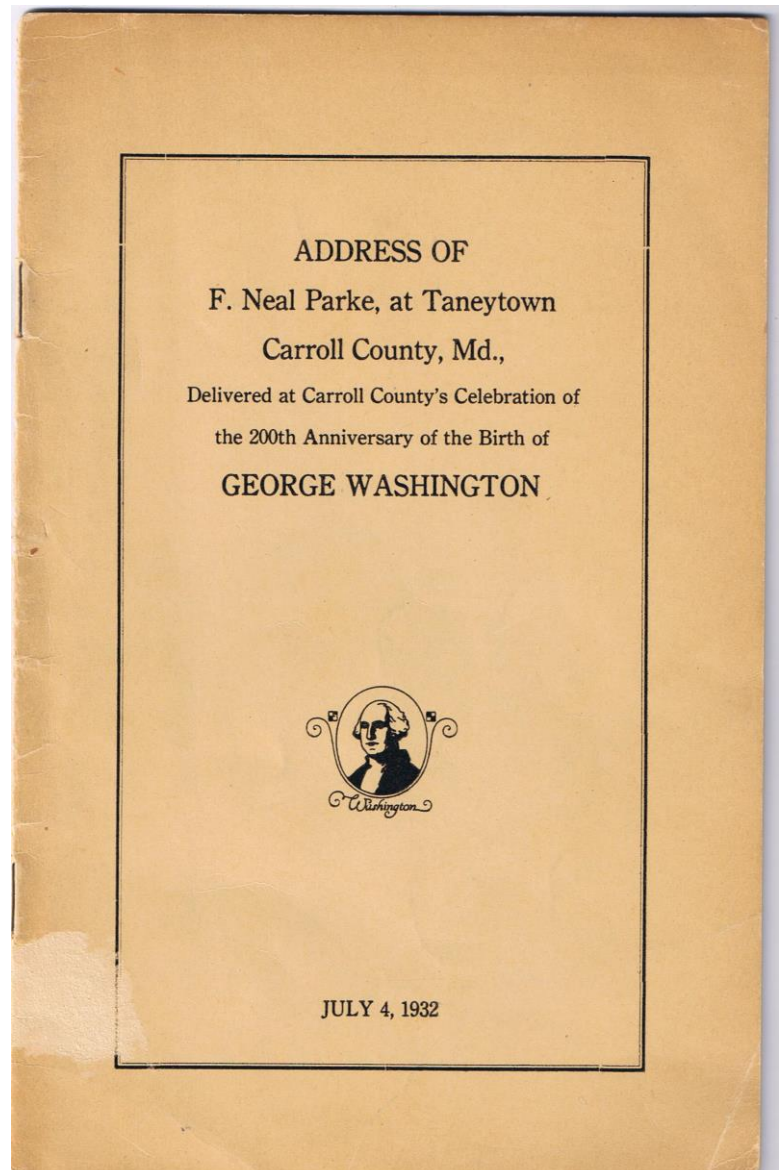
